



Bridgewater Raritan Cheer Association Player and Demonstrator Code of Conduct

As a registered member of the Bridgewater-Raritan Cheerleading teams, I hereby promise to always do my best to obey the rules and regulations known as the Bridgewater-Raritan Player and Demonstrator Code of Conduct:

1. I will show respect for my coaches, teammates, football players, cheerleaders, officials, my opponents, Parent volunteers, and myself always.
2. I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, cheerleader, parent, volunteer, or spectator from the opposing team such as: booing, taunting, name calling.
3. I will treat my coaches and fellow teammates on all program squads with respect and kindness. I understand there is zero tolerance for bullying, harassment, intimidation.
4. I understand if there is any evidence brought forth of bullying, harassment, intimidation whether it is during cheer events or outside it will be addressed accordingly.
5. I will not use profanity, abusive language, or obscene gestures.
6. I will avoid all unsafe behavior at practices and on the sidelines during games.
7. I will refrain from fighting verbally or physically with any person. Fighting will NOT be tolerated.
8. **For demonstrators only:** I will attend all practices, games, competitions/exhibitions and adhere to required attendance policy and if I miss more than 7 events without a verifiable team sport/academic related event, illness or death in the family, I will not be able to complete the program.

Failure to follow the above rules (1-8) will result in a thorough investigation by the board and may result in a verbal warning or other disciplinary actions up to and including removal from the program.

9. I understand there is zero tolerance for use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol.
10. I understand there is zero tolerance if proof is presented on any social media platform of underage use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol, whether it is the participant posting or a posting of them by someone else.
11. I understand there is zero tolerance if a player presents with any signs of impairment at games, practices, competitions, or other program events.
12. **For cheerleaders only:** I understand I am expected to attend all practices, games, competitions/exhibitions and adhere to the required attendance policy. and understand that if I miss more than 7 events without a verifiable illness or death in the family, I will not be able to complete the program and will be removed from the roster with no refund.

Failure to follow the above rules (9-12) is grounds for immediate removal from the program.

I understand that all the above-listed rules and regulations will be held for the duration of the program's season beginning July 15th and inclusive of any pre or post season cheerleading clinics. I also understand that I must abide by all other codes of conduct rules set forth by Pop Warner Little Scholars Inc.
